2012-05-01 <u>Lease Port of Liberty:</u> Motion was made by Coleman, seconded by Herrington and unanimously passed to enter into a lease agreement along with the City of Liberty and the Port of Liberty with Boomerang Tube, LLC on a 9 acre tract of land at the Port of Liberty.

2012-05-06 Water rights permit application: The Board was given the latest correspondence with regard to our water rights permit application.
2012-05-07 <u>Galveston Bay M-20 connector:</u> Motion was made by Wilcox, seconded by Coleman to execute the letter of support for the Chambers County/Galveston Bay M-20 Connector Initiative. Passed Ken Mitchell voted no to this agenda item.
2012-05-08 <u>Lease agreement spoil bank Fort Anahuac Park:</u> Motion was made by Mitchell, seconded by Wilcox and unanimously passed to execute the amended lease agreement with Chambers County on the property and spoil bank located at Fort Anahuac Park. Passed This lease will expire on March 25, 2040.
2012-05-09 <u>Dredging projects:</u> Pudge Willcox reported the Corps is still working on trying to locate spoil placement areas. The District has good monetary reserve if at some point we have to purchase any placement areas.
2012-05-10 Rice Acreage: As a matter of information, the Board was informed that contracts have been signed for 8,000 acres of rice.
